

About 190 counters participated in the Point Reyes CBC on December 15. The weather was breezy and foggy for some, but mostly dry. The highlights included: LONG-TAILED DUCK and 7 TUNDRA SWAN in Abbott's Lagoon, YELLOW-BILLED LOON seen outside the count circle between Tom's Point and Lawson's Landing, 4 CASPIAN TERNS in Tomales Bay, Red Phalarope off Limantour, VIOLET-GREEN AND BARN SWALLOW, PACIFIC GOLDEN PLOVER near Drakes Beach, SNOW GOOSE, RED-NAPED SAPSUCKER a few hundred yards west of White House Pool, 3 BLACK HEADED GROSBEAKS in Inverness, GRASSHOPPER SPARROW in the field east of the Tomales Bay Trail and many raptors including a PRAIRIE FALCON. The tentative species total is 200 species.
